

PULS statement on Conflict Minerals

Through our voluntary commitment to comply with the ZVEI-VDMA Code of Conduct, we are committed to avoiding the use of minerals from conflict and high-risk areas within our supply chain.

To live up to this responsibility, PULS supports the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) and its Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP). The RMAP standards were developed to meet the requirements of the OECD Due Diligence Guidance, Regulation (EU) 2017/821 of the European Parliament and the US Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.

For conflict-free procurement within our supply chains, we use the issued RMI report templates and make them available to our customers in the currently valid form on our homepage.
